

PARTS OF THE SPEECH

Three little words you often see are **ARTICLES**:
a, an, and the.

A **NOUN**'s the name of anything:
school, toy, Joplin, or swing.

ADJECTIVES tell the kind of noun:
great, small, pretty, white, rude, or brown.

VERBS tell of something being done:
To read, write, count, sing, jump, or run.

ADVERBS tell how things are done:
slowly, quickly, badly, well.

CONJUNCTIONS join the words together:
men and women, wind or weather.

The **PREPOSITION** stands before a noun:
in or through a door.
